By completing this course, you will be able to:

- Describe your main duties and responsibilities
- List the standards and codes of conduct and practice that relate to your role.
- Explain how your previous experiences, attitudes and beliefs may affect the way you work.
- Describe your employment rights and responsibilities.
- List the aims, objectives and values of the service in which they work.
- Explain why it is important to work in ways that are agreed with your employer.
- Explain how and when to escalate any concerns you might have (whistleblowing).
- Explain why it is important to be honest and identify where errors may have occurred and to tell the appropriate person.
- Describe your responsibilities to the individuals you support.
- Explain how a working relationship is different from a personal relationship.
- Describe different working relationships in health and social care settings.
- Explain why it is important to work in partnership with key people, advocates and others who are significant to an individual.
